PRIORITY 1- TO CONTINUE TO RAISE THE PERFORMANCE OF ALL STAKEHOLDERS IN THE SCHOOL

Action	Expected Impact
To raise attainment of English across all year groups	Phonics screening % in Y1 and Y2 will be inline or above National average. New Grammarsaurus approach in conjunction with assessment spreadsheets will show a greater % of children working at GD across the school. Handwriting marks in assessment will increase. Oracy will have a direct impact on Reading and writing results. EYFS writing results will have increased to be in line with reading in EYFS.
To continue to enhance the curriculum offer inline with TEEP	The TEEP structure and underpinning values will ensure all children have access to quality first teaching. Red Oaks will have a progression and diverse curriculum offer that will support transition to our Trust Secondary schools. Clear assessment will lead to identification of HA and LA children in all subjects to allow for high quality differentiation.
To continue to enhance the music curriculum offer	Music will have a high profile in the school and children will take up learning musical instruments
To continue to raise attainment across the school by ensuring we are outward-facing	New systems introduced will ensure robust processes and consistency for the wider Trust
