You are invited to create a story with illustrations that can be read aloud to primary age children. The story should be 500 words (estimated) and can be a theme of your choice.

Can you perform a poem. This can be a well-known poem or one you have written yourself.



Your entries are due in school on Monday 24th March and on this day there will be a class story time where stories can be read and poems performed.

Certificates will be awarded to all children who participate, those completed to a high standard will be chosen to be added to a Red Oaks book and shared on the website and class Dojo.



### Important Things

Phonics and spelling homework will be posted weekly on class Dojo and class news on the website. These words will be tested weekly (your class teachers will let you know test days).

Weekly maths homework will be set - this will be focused around number and multiplication and division. Additionally, class teachers will post 'How to' videos for new maths units for you to practice at home.

Lastly, all children are expected to read for pleasure daily. This can be shared reading or independent but listening and asking questions is paramount to creating reading confidence. Guidance for questions will be posted on Dojo and class news on the website.
