



## **Impact of Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Funding 2017-2018**

Below is a summary of how the allocation of Pupil Premium funding for 2017-2018 has impacted upon the academic performance of children at the end of Key Stages.

### **EYFS**

*There were 6 children eligible for Pupil Premium funding from a FS2 cohort of 32 -19%*

50% of the pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding reached GLD compared with 81% non PP pupils.

Progress for this group was 17% at 6+ steps, compared to 8% at 6+ steps for non-PPG pupils.

Of these 3 pupils not achieving GLD, 1 is a high SEN need child, 1 is ASD and 1 is a white British boy with some SEN.

Holy Family GLD for PP pupils is in line with Swindon LA.

### **Phonics Screening Check**

#### **Year 1**

*There were 4 children eligible for Pupil Premium funding from a Year 1 cohort of 41 - 10%.*

25% of the pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved the expected standard in the Year 1 Phonics Screening

#### **End of Key Stage 1**

*There were 7 children eligible for Pupil Premium funding from a Year 1 cohort of 45 - 16%*

86% achieved expected standard or more in reading and maths and 71% achieved expected or more in writing. This was greater or in line with the school's non PPG pupils who achieved 79% in reading, 71% in writing and 84% in maths. This was higher than non-PP pupils and higher than Swindon LA for expected.

#### **End of Key Stage 2**

*There were 8 children eligible for Pupil Premium funding from a cohort of 45 - 18%.*

- 75% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved Expected Standard in **Reading**, compared to 76% other pupils. 38% of PPG pupils achieved GDS, compared to 24% non PPG. The average score for this PPG group was 109, compared to 106 for non PPG.
- 75% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved Expected Standard in **Writing**, compared to 81% other pupils. 38% of PPG pupils achieved GDS, compared to 40% non PPG.
- 88% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved Expected Standard in **Maths**, compared to 81% other pupils. 38% of PPG pupils achieved GDS, compared to 24% non PPG. The average score for this PPG group was 107, compared to 105 for non PPG.
- 75% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved Expected Standard in **SPAG**, compared to 87% other pupils. 38% of PPG pupils achieved GDS, compared to 41% non-PPG. The average score for this PPG group was 114, compared to 108 for non-PPG.
