

Dear Parents/Carers,

PE

Please remind your children if they need to change their books as they have the opportunity almost daily. Reading is very important, please hear your child read as often as possible, this could be their school books or any reading material you have at home e.g. stories, magazines, puzzles, information books etc. Please record this in their books so we can see all their hard work.

Homework/Spellings

Homework will be sent out at the beginning of term with the due date on the top of the sheet. Spellings will be given out on a Monday to be tested the following Monday. Please note that spellings will not be given out over the SATs period.

SATs

KS1 SATs will be taking place during weeks four and five of this term (13th-24th May 2019). The children will still have a normal school day and will be unaware that they are undertaking pieces of work that will then be assessed. Please make sure that children arrive as promptly as possible and have had a good breakfast on these days. If you have any questions about this or would like any extra work to do at home then please do not hesitate to ask.
