Communication & Language

- •Enjoy listening to longer stories and remember much of what happens.
- instruction.
- Be able to express a point of view.
 Can start a conversation with an adult
- •Sina a large repertoire of songs.
- Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books and tell a long story.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- •Select and use activities & resources to achieve a chosen goal.
- •Show more confidence in new socia situations.
- Play with one or more children, extending & elaborating play ideas.
 Help to find solutions to conflicts & rivalries e.g. not everyone can be Spiderman & suggest other ideas
- •Begin to understand how others might be feeling.

Physical Development

- •Develop their movement, balancing, riding & ball skills.
- •Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold of pose for a game like musical statues.
- flags & streamers, paint and make marks.
- •Use one handed tools & equipment e.g. make snips in paper with scissors.
- •Make healthy choices about food and drink
- •Use pens & pencils with good control.

Literacy

- Understand the five key concepts about print.
 Develop phonological awareness, so they can:
 - spot & suggest rhyme
- count/clap syllables in vords
- recognise words with the same initial sound.
- •Talk about simple stories & re-tell with actions.
- •Increase vocabulary & converse with others.
- •Write some or all of their
- •Writes some letters accurately.

At home:

- Learn to recognise/make/ write their name.
- To hear initial sounds 'I spy'.
 Enjoy books from the library.
 Find/spot words that rhyme.

Mathematics

- •Subitising objects up to 3 (know the amount without counting).
- •Recite numbers past 5.
- •Say one number for each item in order 1 2 3 4 5.
- •Know that the last number when counting tells you the total (Cardinal principle).
- •Compare quantities using 'more than', 'fewer than'.
- •Compare objects by size, length, weight, capacity.
- •Talk about & explore simple 2D & 3D shapes. •Extend & create ABAB

At home:

 Count objects one to one, using correct no. sequence.
 Talk about & name simple flat & solid shapes.

Understanding the World

- •Talk about changes- Spring to Summer (Seasons)
- •Use all their senses in exploring natural materials.
- ·Explore how things work.
- •Plant seeds & care for growing plants.
- •Understand key features of life cycles plants animals.
- •Explore and talk about different forces they feel.
- •Talk about differences between materials and
- •Develop positive attitudes about the differences between people.

At home:

- ❖ Grow some plants or flowers.
- ❖Discuss lifecycles & change e.g. butterflies, Spring to Summer.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Take part in simple pretend play.
- •Explore different materials & decide what to make.
- •Explore colour & colour mixing.
- Create 'flower' artwork inspired by the artist Georges Seurat
- •Draw with increasing complexity & detail
- Play instruments with ncreasing control to express feelings & ideas.

At home:

- Explore colour & mixing.Copy/create some simple rhythms.
- *Talk about textures of things, develop vocabulary e.g. smooth, prickly, bumpy.























