Homework

Dates

Please find the attached list of key dates for the year. Please note that these are subject to change or cancellation. We aim to give as much notice as possible when dates change and try not to make changes unless absolutely necessary as we know many of you may need to arrange time off work. Sometimes, situations beyond our control mean that events are moved. Please keep an eye on the newsletter and website for any changes.

Change of Details

If you have moved house, changed phone number or email or have any other change in circumstance you feel we should know about, please contact the office ASAP. It is vital that we hold the correct details for you so that you receive all correspondence and we can also get hold of you should we need to.

Emails from School

Please check your junk mail periodically as apparently our emails sometimes go into this folder and parents miss important messages. We do try to text and put messages on Facebook and Dojo also but more lengthy communications and newsletters will be sent via email. Thank you.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle in school. Under the circumstances, children are not permitted to use water fountains. We do have some disposable cups in classrooms if children forget but it is easier if they bring their own bottle.

Care Plan Medication and Inhalers

Please ensure your child has any relevant medication in school with them. These medications need to be handed to the class teacher and it is the responsibility of the parent to ensure the medication is in date. Unfortunately, we are unable to administer medicines in school unless your child has a care plan drawn up by the school nurse. We will continue to run assemblies virtually in classrooms and we will also continue to celebrate the achievements of children outside of school. Please visit our 'Wall of Talent' to post achievements that you would like us to share in assembly.

PE Kits

PE is a compulsory curriculum subject and children should keep their PE kit in school all week. This should be in a drawstring bag that takes up minimal space as cloakrooms and lockers are very small. **Children are only permitted to bring rucksacks if they cycle or scoot to school.** If your child cannot take part in PE, a note signed by a parent/carer should be given to the class teacher. Children **MUST** wear a plain house coloured t-shirt so that teams can be easily identified and **football shirts will not be accepted as PE kit.** Trainers or daps must also be brought as suitable footwear and earrings must be taped up or removed. Children with long hair must have this tied up please.

Please ensure that **ALL uniform is clearly marked with your child's name,** including their shoes, as this will enable the quick return of any mislaid items. Many thanks.

No Nuts

We politely request that no nuts are brought into school in lunch boxes as we do have children with severe allergies that can be life threatening. This includes peanut butter which we do not allow in sandwiches. Thank you for your help.



School Lunches

Sodexo have requested that **ALL** meals are ordered for the week by **THURSDAY** evening on ParentPay. This includes children receiving Universal Free School Meals (Rec-Year 2) and Free School Meals. **If meals are not ordered in advance, you will receive a text to bring your child in a packed lunch.**



Snack

Fruit snacks are provided for children in Foundation stage and Key Stage 1 at break time. Children in Key Stage 2 are welcome to bring a snack but we ask that this is a piece of fruit or vegetable please. Please do not send in cereal bars or snacks such as fruit winders or anything in a wrapper. We are trying to encourage our children to be healthy.

Car Park

We ask politely that **ONLY** vehicles with disabled badges park in the disabled bays as we have children and parents with genuine need.



Pupil Premium

All children who currently qualify for free school meals based on their family circumstances are entitled to pupil premium. This applies if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7,400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

If your child is entitled to Universal Free School meals (Years Reception to 2) then your child will not qualify for Pupil Premium unless you are also in receipt of any of the above benefits.

An application for Pupil Premium funding will need to be made for each child in your household. The money that the school receives is assigned to individual children but is used to narrow the gap for disadvantaged children in general and benefit all the wider school population.

If you think that your child qualifies for Pupil Premium funding, please collect an application form from the school office.

Reading

Reading is a fundamental key to accessing the curriculum and we encourage children to read as much as they can. Even the older children enjoy having a story at bedtime and that special time with a parent. There is a direct correlation between the academic achievements of children with how much they read. Early Excellence research shows that:



- By 22 months - a child's language development can predict outcomes at age 26
- By 2 years - 75% of a child's brain growth has already occurred.
- By ages 3-6 - a child's narrative skills are a powerful predictor of literacy skill at 8-12 years.
- By 4 years - the difference in the number of words children from disadvantaged backgrounds hear is 19 million.
- By age 5 - a child's vocabulary will predict their educational success and outcomes at age 30.

COVID-19

Thank you for bearing with us at this difficult time. We are continually receiving new guidance and will pass information on to you that is necessary. We are required to send children home if they are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19. If these are key symptoms **only**, you will be required to have your child tested. If your child has other symptoms, please monitor for 48 hours. If symptoms persist or new symptoms develop, please arrange a test. Please **do not** send your child back to school even if the test is negative if they still have **key symptoms**.

Key Symptoms	New or continuous cough OR Fever 37.8+ OR Loss of or change in smell/taste
Other symptoms	Shortness of breath Fatigue (tiredness) Loss of appetite Muscles ache Sore throat Headache Nasal congestion Diarrhoea, nausea and vomiting

If you are unsure, please call the school and we will do our best to help.
