Deaf Awareness Week takes place every year in the UK and is taking place from the 2nd to the 8th of May and this year's theme is "Access to Communication." The purpose of Deaf Awareness Week is to help break down communication barriers, encourage better communication between deaf and hearing individuals and promoting social inclusion of deaf children and adults.

At Red Oaks Primary school we have 14 children and adults who are Deaf but did you know there are 12 million people in the UK who are deat and  $\underline{151,000}$  people using British Sign Language. Did you know Red Oaks has a BSL Club where everyone can learn BSL and some of our class teachers and staff have Level 1 in BSL! Red Oaks pupils are great at

signing in our singing assemblies. We will have a special Deaf Awareness assembly, where will be looking at how we communicate with each other and how deaf people communicate with their pets and we will announce a special competition- design a funky and cool hearing aid/cochlear implant. The communication Ambassadors will be picking the winner.
