# Emails from School

#### Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a named water bottle in school. These must contain water only. All Reception children will receive a free water bottle from school this week.

# Care Plan Medication and Inhalers

Please ensure your child has any relevant medication in school with them. These medications need to be handed to the class teacher and it is the responsibility of the parent to ensure the medication is in date. Unfortunately, we are unable to administer medicines in school unless your child has a care plan drawn up by the school nurse. If you think your child needs a care plan and doesn't yet have one, please contact Mrs Tyler in the office. Please refer to our full medical policy on the website for further information.





# Uniform/PE Kits

PE is a compulsory curriculum subject and children should keep their PE kit in school all week. This should be in a drawstring bag that takes up minimal space as cloakrooms and lockers are very small. <u>Children are only</u> <u>permitted to bring rucksacks if they cycle or scoot to school</u>. If your child cannot take part in PE, a note signed by a parent/carer should be given to the class teacher. Children <u>MUST</u> wear a plain house coloured t-shirt so that teams can be easily identified and football shirts will not be accepted as PE kit. Trainers or daps must also be brought as suitable footwear and earrings must be taped up or removed. Children with long hair must have this tied up please.

Please ensure that <u>ALL uniform is clearly marked with your child's name</u>, including their shoes, as this will enable the quick return of any mislaid items. Many thanks.

#### School Lunches

Sodexo have requested that ALL meals are ordered for the week by THURSDAY evening on ParentPay. This includes children receiving Universal Free School Meals (Rec-Year 2) and Free School Meals. If meals are not ordered in advance, you will receive a text to bring your child in a packed lunch.



We politely request that no nuts are brought into school in lunch boxes as we do have children with severe allergies that can be life threatening. This includes peanut butter which we <u>do not</u> allow in sandwiches. This also includes Nutella. As we promote healthy eating, please also do not send sweets in lunchboxes. Thank



you for your help.

# <u>Snack</u>

Fruit snacks are provided for children in Foundation stage and Key Stage 1 at break time. Children in Key Stage 2 are welcome to bring a snack but we ask that this is a piece of fruit or vegetable please. Please do not send in cereal bars or snacks such as fruit winders or anything in a wrapper. We are trying to encourage our children to be healthy.

# <u>Car Park</u>



We ask politely that **ONLY** vehicles with disabled badges park in the disabled bays as we have children and parents as well as Access buses and taxis with genuine need. The 'Kiss and Drop' bay will always have a member of staff to help collect children in the morning. Please only park in this area if you are using 'Kiss and Drop'.

# <u>Pupil Premium</u>

All children who currently qualify for free school meals based on their family circumstances are entitled to pupil premium. This applies if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7,400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

If your child is entitled to Universal Free School meals (Years Reception to 2) then your child will not qualify for Pupil Premium unless you are also in receipt of any of the above benefits.

An application for Pupil Premium funding will need to be made for <u>each child in your household</u>. The money that the school receives is assigned to individual children but is used to narrow the gap for disadvantaged children in general and benefit all the wider school population.

If you think that your child qualifies for Pupil Premium funding, please collect an application form from the school office.

Class DoJo is a brilliant way to keep up to date with your child's learning in school. We also update the 'Whole School Story' regularly with all of the events and activities that are happening in school.


#### After School Clubs


#### Mighty Oaks Yoga Club
