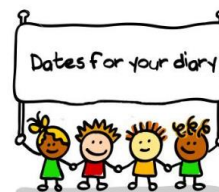
Year 6 - have had a blast in Pencelli this week. See pictures below. 😊

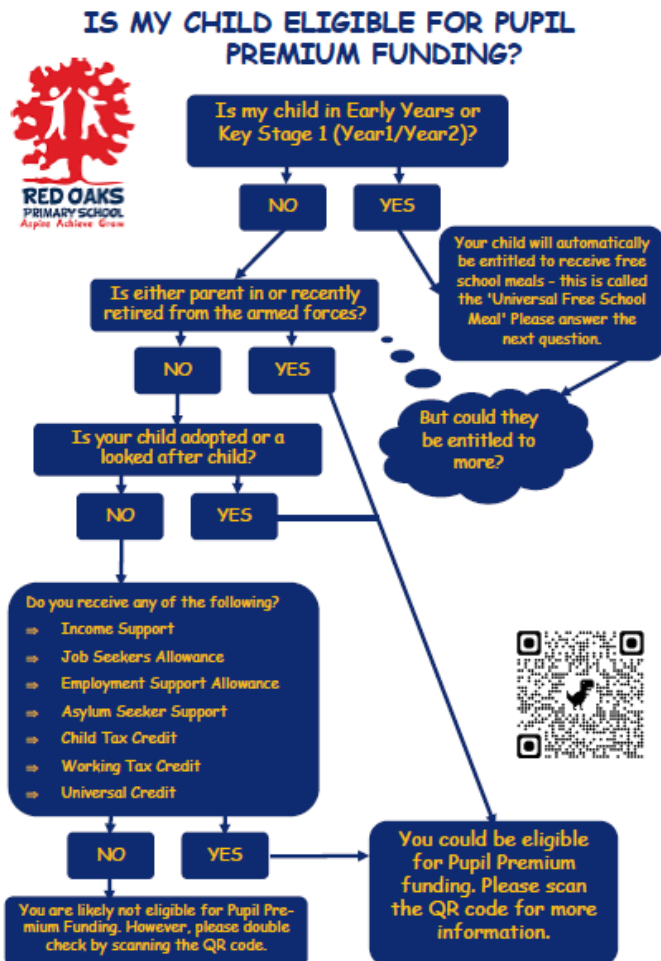
