

To miss school is to miss the many experiences that shape the choices we make, the

opportunities we have and the quality of life that we lead.

There is a wide range of evidence that tells us that children who attend school regularly go on to achieve better outcomes, to live healthier, wealthier and more enriched lives and we want to make sure we are all doing everything that we can to make that happen for all of our children.

The table below shows the number of days absent from school and the impact on learning.
