

Your entries are due in school on Monday 21st October and on this day there will be in class heats. The winners of each class will compete in an assembly that week.

Certificates will be awarded for the class winners and there will be a prize for the whole school champion, for the most successful boat and aeroplane.

Important Things

Phonics and spelling homework will be posted weekly on class Dojo and class news on the website. These words will be tested weekly (your class teachers will let you know test days).

Weekly maths homework will be set - this will be focused around number and multiplication and division. Additional, class teachers will post 'How to' videos for new maths units for you to practice at home.

Lastly, all children are expected to read for pleasure daily. This can be shared reading or independent but listening and asking questions is paramount to creating reading confidence. Guidance for questions will be posted on Dojo and class news on the website.
