Our Parent Support Advisors have a wide range of experience in family support. They:-

- Are Level 5 or accredited practitioners
- Are trained and experienced in facilitating Family Links, Managing Challenging Behaviour, PEEP, Talking Teens and Triple P online programmes
- Work with children and families experiencing a number of different challenges and needs
- Have experience of the Team Around the Child (TAC) process
- Have experience of working with children with additional needs. Some are EarlyBird and EarlyBird Plus trained
- Receive monthly supervision and guidance
- Provide longer term, needs-led support for families and children in the home.
- Will visit children in school or Early Years settings



What we do for families:

Parent Support Advisors offer 1:1 family support at home and with children in Early Years settings and school. We work with families providing support and advice on a wide range of issues:

- Understanding and supporting challenging behaviour
- Parenting strategies
- Building self confidence and self esteem
- Family routines or breakdown
- Home school relationships or transitions
- Supporting children's learning and development
- Domestic abuse support and advice (current or historic)
- The impact on families of Drug and Alcohol abuse
- Parental and child mental health concerns
- Specialised parenting support for children with ASC or ADHD
- Benefits and housing advice and support
- Bereavement
- Access to a range of parenting and nurturing programmes including Family Links and Managing Challenging Behaviour
- Engagement with the Early Help and Team Around the Child process.
- Access to groups for families with children aged under 5 years, and peer support groups for parents.
